

### **INSTRUCTIONS/GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS**

- 1. CBSE Cluster-XII Volleyball Championship from 1 August to 4 August 2025. All matches will be on knock out basis.
- 2. Groups: As per age Category.

- 5. Details must be submitted latest by 20th July 2025 for the smooth conduction of the event.
- 6. The inauguration of the Championship will be held on 1st August 2025 at 12:00 p.m. The first round of matches will start after the Inauguration Ceremony.
- 7. Teams will be provided accommodation in the school premises. Teams will be responsible for their belongings and are requested not to carry any jewellry, cash or valuable items.
- 8. Proof of payment of ANNUAL SPORTS FEE 2025-26.
- 9. Only vegetarian food will be served at the aforesaid mentioned schedule.
- 10. As per CBSE guidelines, each participant has to submit Rs. 500/-per head per day for fooding, lodging and other facilities, totaling to Rs. 2000/- for 4 days (1st Aug to 4th Aug 2025) to be submitted on the day of arrival.

### CBSE rules for participants and teacher/staff accompanying them.

No part payment will be accepted. Rs. 2000/- per school (Three thousand only) will be submitted as security deposit which shall be refunded in full at the time of departure in case there is no damage or loss.

#### **Important Information:**

#### IT SHALL BE MANDATORY-

- 1. To provide the documents for verification in original if asked for.
- 2.To provide the team photo with school Principal along with the entry Proforma, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- 3. For student/player studying in class IX and above, must provide CBSE registration no., Eligibility/Entry Proforma & ID Card.
- 4. Every school must supply the signed copy of eligibility Proforma filled in online to the host school on arrival.
- 5. No team will be allowed to participate without team Manager/Coach.
- 6.Over age player or player from outside school agency: In case a school sends an over- age player or player from outside agency, and is caught, the school will immediately be disqualified. And if the same school repeats such act again, its name will be forwarded to the Board's Affiliation Branch for necessary action under Affiliation by Laws.
- 7.All coaches/ managers and players must have their I-card available at all times and they will stay along with their participants.
- 8. After registration, players of any team cannot go out of school without permission.
- 9.If the coach and manager of any team wants to go out of the school, then they have to inform the Organizing Committee.
- 10. No team should have an extra member with them.
- 11. Any friend or relative called by you during the competition will not be allowed to enter the school premises.
- 12.The team members will protect their valuables themselves and if they are lost, the school will not be responsible for them.









- 13. No player is allowed
- to leave the premises after 6:30 p.m.
- 14. You will fully assist the school cleaner in keeping the school clean.
- 15. Any type of intoxication is prohibited inside the school, and if any student or coach/manager is caught taking Gutka, Paanparag, drugs, alcohol etc. then he or she will be disqualified from the competition at any stage.
- 16.If any property of the school is destroyed or damaged by a member of any team, they will be disqualified from the competition and complain will be lodged to the CBSE Board.
- We will be strict about it. This is our dream school and anyone damaging it, will not be tolerated. You are our guest but certain etiquettes have to be maintained, as you all are from educated class.
- 17. Whenever a full introduction of any member of your team is asked by the Organizing Committee, you should give full introduction to them, it is mandatory from security point of view.
- 18. Food
- will not be provided to you without a meal coupon or after the specified time.
- 19. Discipline is the first priority for us. So, all the teams are expected to form a line and wait for their turn to get food. If found indiscipline, strict action will be taken. It is important to mention here that we have "0" tolerance for indiscipline. Sports teach us discipline so sportsperson is expected to be disciplined.
- 20. Food will not be served after the scheduled time mentioned on coupons. You should maintain time schedule.
- 21. It is mandatory for all team members to participate in the opening ceremony of the CBSE Sports Meet.It is strictly prohibited to order any kind of food inside rooms of the school from outside or canteen. All eatables \should be consumed at place/area provided by the school.
- 22. It is mandatory for all the contestants to wear their school dress in the opening ceremony of the competition.
- 23. Photographing and recording from mobile or any electronic goods during the competition is strictly prohibited. If you are found recording or photographing, then your mobile or electronic goods which you are using will be seized and action will be taken against you.
- 24. You can take photos of the players while receiving the medals.
- 25. All the teams have to carefully fill the form provided along with the Invitation letter and submit it to the organizing committee on time.
- 26. If you are found troubling other team members with your cell phones or any other electronic gadgets then action will be taken against you.
- 27. As per mentioned time no one is allowed to move around in the school campus for any reason from their respective allotted rooms.
- 28. You are requested to bring your own lock and key. Don't keep any valuable things in the room. The host team will not be responsible for any such loss.





#### **DISQUALIFICATIONS**

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
- 3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- 4. Usage of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
- 5. Misbehavior with officials/opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
- 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
- 7. Damaging the school property.
- 8. Non-participation in March Past.

The organizing school in no case shall show the eligibility proforma or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents. The organizing school shall submit details of the defaulters to the Jt. Director (Sports) reporting the names of the schools/athletes in a separate cover. All such defaulters will be debarred from the participation in CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition for the next year. If any of such schools resorts to unfair means again, in the subsequent years, it will be debarred for three years.

#### **PROTEST**

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within 30 minutes of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.

2000/-. Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of the following -

- 1. Principal, Organizing School
- 2. Organizing Secretary
- 3. CBSE observer
- 4. One or Two technically qualified people present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is uphold, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be fortified.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding. The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Jt. Director (sports) CBSE.

#### **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS**

- 1) Team Manager/Coaches shall provide the required documents for verification in original, if asked for by the controller.
- 2) Team photo with school principal along with the entry proforma duly countersigned by the concerned principal shall be produced at the time of entry in the school campus.
- 3) All the competitors shall provide CBSE Registration UID number.
- 4) Identity cards to be brought by the students and coaches duly stamped and signed by the principal.
- 5) Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports fee for the year 2025-26









#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. Age Criteria: A player shall be under 14, 17,& 19 years of age as 31.12.2025: Accordingly, for session 2025-26 sports events, the age criteria will be as

follows: A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited i.e. one player can't be the part of more than one team.

- Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2012
- Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2009
- Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2007
- 2. Each participant must carry identity card with photograph duly signed by the head of the institution, valid for the current year; Participant must be in the condition to represent the same whenever it is asked by the competent authority.
- 3. Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the inter school tournament. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to the disqualification of the team.

#### You are requested to bring the following documents without fail.

- a. Photocopy of demand draft paid to CBSE as sports fee for the year 2025.
- b. Printout of the individual identity certificate with UID no. provided by the CBSE.
- c. School Identity Card of the Current session.
- d. Printout of entry Proforma along with original consisting of serial no., Name, Adm. No., Class, Section, Father's Name and photograph duly attested by the principal of the participating schools. (Both hard copy & printout)
- e. A team photo with school principal countersigned by the concerned principal.
- f. Photocopy of the registration certificate of the students/players if they are studying in IX or above.
- g. If the student is studying in Grade IX or below Grade IX, Mark Sheet of the class last passed and an attested copy of Birth Certificate is required.
- h. All the Coaches and Managers and officials should carry school identity cards approved by principal.
- i. Two sets of school flag.
- j. Locks and Key

#### The coaches/team managers will be responsible for maintaining the discipline of their respective teams.

- 1. The participating school Principal should sign the eligibility Performa.
- 2. The form should not bear unauthorized or over writings, as the organizing school would not treat as valid.
- 3. Incomplete Performa in any respect will not be entertained.
- 4. All the supporting paper verifying the age of the player etc. in original shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/ Coach while reporting for the participation. Students studying in class IX and above must provide CBSE registration number /card. Students studying in class XI & XII must carry class X marks cum grade certificate with photo issued by the Board.
- 5. The decision of the referee on all technical aspects will be final.
- 6. Protest against the decision of official on a point of rule and protest of any other nature in connection with the game shall be in writing and must reach to the Organizing Secretary within 30 minutes of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied with a fee receipt of Rs. 2000 /- (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) to the office. The Jury of Appeal will consider such a protest.
- 7. The school will not be responsible for any item/s lost by participants during their stay. It should be ensured that the costly items are kept under lock and key. It will be the responsibility of the team managers to take care of the sick or injured player /s of their team. However, the sick students and officials may report to our school medical in-charge for First Aid.
- 8. As per the rules of CBSE Sports Committee, if a school after sending the entry wishes to withdraw its team from the tournament, it shall be given in a written notice of its intention to do so to the organizing secretary. School withdrawing without informing to the organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs. 2000/-





- 9. Each contingent must bring its school flag as it would be required for the march past at the inaugural ceremony.
- 10. The winning team first & second position at cluster level shall qualify to take part in National Level tournaments.
- 11. Please ensure that the names of the participants are written legibly without spelling mistakes to facilitate proper certification.

#### **BOARDING AND LODGING**

- 1. Accommodation arrangement for boys team will be made. will be provided by the host school.
- 2. Meals will be arranged by the school. The meal coupons may be collected by the team managers on their arrival on payment of Rs.500/- per head per day which includes both boarding and bedding charges. This intimation shall be given in the enclosed Performs. Time schedule is given below.

Breakfast: 07.30 AM to 8.30AM Lunch: 12.00 Noon to 1.30PM Snacks: 03.30 PM to 4.30PM Dinner: 07.30 PM to 8.30PM

Above mentioned (breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner) will be provided at the allotted place only and within the schedule timings.

- 3. Outside food is not permitted due to hygienic reasons.
- 4. The main gate of the school will remain closed for the participants from 10.00 pm to 5.00 am. No one will be allowed to go out or come inside during this period.
- 5. Laundry facility will not be available in the school during the tournament.
- 6. Each team must submit following Annexure at the time of reporting:

a. Annexure I and II

b. Annexure III&V

c. Annexure IV

#### **DISCIPLINE**

- 1. Each school will send one responsible staff member as the Manager of the team. He/she will be responsible for
- his team on and off the field and the Team Manager will be fully responsible to maintain discipline. In case of any indiscipline, the team will be sent back at the same time.
- 2. All the teams and their escorts/ in-charge will be under the administrative control of the Principal, Chairman & Organizing Committee.
- 3. Any damages done at the venue of the stay or to the property of the school during the stay by participants will have to be compensated by the respective team manager / coach.
- 4. Consumption of tobacco, liquor is strictly prohibited during the conduct of the tournament and stay in the school. Our campus is smoke free zone. Anyone found guilty of consuming liquor, tobacco and drugs will be immediately removed from the school campus.
- 5. The decision taken by the jury in any dispute or appeal will be final and binding.

#### **SECURITY DEPOSIT**

An amount of Rs.3000- (Three thousand only) per school should be deposited at the time of registration on arrival of the team towards Security Deposit which will be refunded at the time of departure after making deductions, if any, for the damages done to school property by the team.

Note: We request you to inform us regarding your arrival plans well in advance so that transport arrangement from the Bus Stand Railway Station could be made.
